Drs. John and Radine Frisbie Scholarship	To provide financial assistance to teacher candidates. Awarded annually, and preferably to special education teacher candidates.
Hannah-Joy T. Mankey Endowed Scholarship Fund	To provide financial support for students with demonstrated financial need (undergraduate and graduate), especially students majoring in ELL, ELTG, or minoring in missions.
Hazel Tyson Ware Endowed Scholarship	Awarded in order of preference: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students pursuing a bachelor's degree in education with an emphasis in special education with a desire to work with hard of hearing and speech impaired students. 2. Students pursuing a bachelor's degree in education with an emphasis in special education.
International Student Education Scholarship Fund	To provide support to international students enrolled in the College of Education.
John and Heidi Bersin Scholarship	To provide financial assistance to teacher candidates. Must meet one of the following criteria: female Bulgarian, International student, majoring in education, with a GPA of 3.0 or better
Josephine Richard Memorial Scholarship for Christian Education	To provide financial support to students majoring in Christian education with demonstrated financial need, having divorced biological parents or one or no surviving parent.
Mary Martha Black Scholarship	To provide financial support for freshman and sophomore students with declared education majors with a GPA of at least 2.0. Money can be applied to tuition, room and board, textbooks, supplies, or student school loans. Candidates are eligible for up to two years.
Nina Curtis Jacke Scholarship	To provide financial assistance to undergraduate and graduate education students.
Ruth L. Lusardi Scholarship	To provide financial assistance to undergraduate and graduate education students.
Temple Foundation Scholarship	To provide financial support to undergraduate teacher candidates or first- and second-year teachers who agree to teach or currently teach in Title 1 and urban schools.
The Guy and Clevia Braselton Annual Fund	To provide financial support for one ORU student who majors in education, maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0, and demonstrates financial need.
The Hallberg Family Endowed Scholarship	To provide financial support for ORU Graduate School of Education students. Must meet one of the following criteria: Minimum GPA of 2.7, actively volunteers, has a military or nursing background, is involved with Christian church or religious organizations, or is a US citizen from Minnesota or Wisconsin.
